Girls Inc. preps for Women of Inspiration

Inspirational women and ambitious girls will take center stage at Girls Inc. of Carpinteria's Women of Inspiration luncheon on Monday, April 4 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at 5315 Foothill Road. Arlene Samen, founder of One Heart World-Wide, will serve as this year's featured speaker. A nurse practitioner in maternal fetal medicine for 30-plus years, Samen's whole life changed when His Holiness the Dalai Lama asked her to take her expertise to help pregnant women in Tibet, where one out of 10 newborns died due to preventable causes.
